

Silverdale School is an extremely popular and high-achieving 11-18 comprehensive in the south west of Sheffield and is now the founding school of Chorus Education Trust. The school is rated as 'Outstanding' (Ofsted 2014) and recently achieved the best A-level results of any state school in Sheffield. At its heart is one of the country's largest Teaching Schools, the Sheffield Teaching School Alliance. Silverdale moved into a brand new building in January 2009 with a full complement of facilities.
